NEW BUSINESS:

Butler Public Library Participating Agreement: City Clerk Vicki Wainwright explained that it was the time of year to re-commit to the participating agreement between the City of Butler and the Pine Mountain Regional Library. This agreement is made each year. A motion to re-commit to the participating agreement was made by Councilperson Deborah Williams and a second was made by Councilperson Jacob Hopkins. The vote was unanimous. *(Mayor Pro-Tem Ed Guinn and Councilmember Amanzie Jenkins was absent)*

DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

Public Works Director David Windham said that the 2019 CDBG is finishing up and the punch list should be done this week. He also said that the City had sustained some lightening damage in the approximate amount of \$15,000 to pumps and controls and the City is working with the Insurance Company at this time to get it repaired/replaced.

Police Chief Matthew Woodard said that the police department had 151 calls last month and issued 83 citations.

Fire Coordinator Eddie Moulton said that the Fire Department ran twenty-five calls last month. Those included nine alarm calls, three cancelled calls, eight vehicle accidents, one structure fire, three trees down, and one helicopter landing. He also said that the Butler Fire Department has ten firefighters taking a Firefighter 2 class, and that the pump tests for the fire trucks is scheduled for October.

ADJOURN: With nothing further to discuss, the meeting was adjourned with a motion by Councilperson Glenn Harris and a second by Councilperson Deborah Williams. The vote was unanimous. *(Mayor Pro-Tem Ed Guinn and Councilmember Amanzie Jenkins was absent)*
