DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

Police Chief Matthew Woodard said that the football coach from Taylor County High School has requested a \$2000.00 donation to help purchase new helmets for the football team. He has requested the same amount from the City of Reynolds and Taylor County Sheriff's Office. Councilperson Glenn Harris made a motion to make the donation and Councilperson Rodrick Flowers (via phone) made the second. The vote was unanimous. *Mayor Pro-Tem Guinn and Councilperson Jacob Hopkins were absent.

*After the vote Councilperson Williams asked the Clerk to check to make sure that a donation could be made from taxpayer dollars. The Clerk will consult with the City Attorney on the issue to determine if the donation can be made.
